

MIDDELSEEROUTE ● UK

About 1000 years ago, Friesland looked a lot different than now. With on the west-side the Zuiderzee and on the other side the former Middelzee that reached until the line Dokkum-Stavoren. A long time ago, the Middelseeroute was an important sailing connection, that linked the 11 cities. This historical sailing route is restored in honor.

It is possible to sail from Leeuwarden, Franeker and Bolsward to the beautiful water sports center of Sneek, without having to detour. This is an attractive alternative for the Prinses Margriet canal, which you are not allowed to sail. Multiple attractive old villages are accessible from this route. They offer museums, shopping centers characteristic churches and monumental buildings.
